AIR SCOOP

TRAINING AREA (SOUTH) - PROCEDURE

Up to this time the unofficial procedure and practice when flying in the training area south of Regina has been to stay on and monitor Tower frequency once ATC clears our aircraft en-route. Recent events have come into play where we have had to look at this matter and consider a more formal policy and a change to our communication procedure for flight training and RFC flights in the Regina training area.

Effective immediately the policy and procedure for communication in the training area south of Regina shall require RFC pilots, once cleared to en-route by ATC, to switch to en-route frequency (126.7) and monitor 126.7 while in the training area. The procedures are as follows:

- once cleared en-route by ATC switch to 126.7
- on 126.7 broadcast your aircraft, location (position and altitude) and intentions for flight in the Regina training area
- monitor 126.7 while in the training area
- if need be communicate with other RFC aircraft in the training area on 126.7

• upon departure from the training area switch to Regina ATC Tower frequency (118.6) and inform them of your aircraft, location and intentions

Also, a reminder, if you intend to conduct a flight in the south training area you must receive and retain on board a training area section card and conduct your flight within the boundaries of that section.
