- 1. Co-Pilot Course- Now in beta testing. Includes 1 hour ground instruction and 3 hours in yours or RFC aircraft. Can be tailored to your needs or wishes. Please contact Mike Meehan 525-6194 if you are interested in this course. \$270 + gst, based on your aircraft.
- 2. Open House-Has been rescheduled to Sunday September 17th due to construction near our ramp.
- 3. "Do it with Glass"- GTM being considered for an avionics upgrade due to an unforeseen avionics problem. The Board will soon be considering a decision request to install two Garmin G5 glass upgrades including an AI and DG and horizontal situation indicator (HSI). If the decision is to proceed, it may still be a number of weeks to obtain the 2 panels and schedule the installation. This will eliminate the need for a vacuum pump.
- **4. Airport Construction- Construction** on our ramp area is now complete.

We are however going to be affected by other construction including the closure of the new Taxiway "Charlie" from June 15th to July 5th. Other construction closures include Bravo 1 and Mike from June 7th to June 14th. This requires special procedures for backtracking on runway 13/31. Rental pilots be sure to discuss with an RFC Instructor before departing during these dates.

5. On-Line Payment capability- coming to our website. This will allow purchase of RFC Gift Certificates, Pilot for an Hour flights, etc. all from the comfort of your home. Watch for this on our website in the near future.

6. Pilot lounge- Demolition and construction is well under way with great thanks to Kyle Jacques and the staff of Winmar Disaster Restoration! Substantial completion is targeted for Open House-Sept. 17th.
