NEW LOCATION FOR THE FIC

As of April 8, 2010, all Sask. pilots will no longer be dealing with Edmonton Flight Information Centre. As of that date, we will be talking to the Winnipeg FIC. That means when you dial 1-866-WXBRIEF, you will get Winnipeg. Also, you can call Winnipeg FIC from anywhere in North America by dialing 1-866-541-4103.

This means that all your flight planning, weather briefing and enroute services will be done with Winnipeg. All calls to the enroute RCO's (FISE) in Buffalo Narrows, La Ronge, North Battleford, Prince Albert, Regina, Saskatoon, Stony Rapids, Swift Current, Wollaston Lake and Yorkton will all be answered by Winnipeg. The local advisory frequencies will remain with the current provider such as Yorkton and Regina will be answered by Regina Radio.

All the services offered by Edmonton FIC will now be done by Winnipeg. Edmonton will now be dealing with Alberta and Northeastern British Columbia.




